My 4th Great Grandfather was Thomas Patmore (in the 1861 Census he is listed as John Patmore c.1803) and his wife was Sarah. Their son (my 3rd Great Grandfather) was Charles Patmore (wife Ann Honey) and their daughter - Jemima Ann Patmore was my Great Great Grandmother (1854 - 1936).
